Fall Exploration Trip 2015

November 12-18, 2015

**Have you ever wanted to see more of the Dominican Republic and learn more about the programs supported by the Episcopal Church?** Here is your opportunity to take a long weekend to visit our brothers and sisters in Christ in the Dominican Republic and see first hand the social, educational and religious programs administered through the Dominican Episcopal Church. Many of those programs are supported by our companion dioceses.

This trip is designed to minimize the travel time and still allow the group to see many parts of the country, meet the priests and community leaders who run the programs and see first hand the families and communities who benefit from these programs. The trip will be guided by Karen Carroll and Bill Kunkle. Karen Carroll is a missionary who lives in Santo Domingo and is in charge of organizing the many mission teams who come to the Dominican Republic each year. Bill Kunkle is the Executive Director of the Dominican Development Group and has been organizing and leading mission teams to the Dominican Republic for 16 years.

This year the trip will travel an East-West path. We will visit Santo Domingo, San Pedro de Macorís, Santa Fe, Boca Chica, Jimani, Barahona, Baní, Azua, La Romana and numerous other cities.

The cost for the trip including hotel, meals, and local transportation is US\$800.00. This **does not** include your airfare. The cost for the airfare varies from your departure city but it is generally inexpensive this time of year to travel to the Dominican Republic. We will fly into Santo Domingo (SDQ) on Thursday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, and return flights will depart on Wednesday, November 19<sup>th</sup>, from Santo Domingo (SDQ). Participants may choose to extend their visit to the island. If you would like to stay a few extra days and enjoy some R&R in Punta Cana or La Romana, please speak to Bill Kunkle **BEFORE** you book your flight.
